- We offer funded places in accordance with the Code of Practice for ... and any local conditions in place at the time.
- we will keep a place vacant, if this is financially viable, in order to accommodate emergency
- admissions
- we will describe the pre-school and its practices in terms which make it clear that it welcomes both fathers and mothers, other relations and other carers, including childminders, and
- people from all cultural, ethnic and social groups, with and without disabilities
- We ensure that the setting and its practices operate in a way that encourages positive regard for and understanding of difference and ability whether gender, family structure, class, background, religion, ethnicity or competence in spoken English.

- we consult with families about the opening times of the pre-school to avoid excluding anyone
- we try to be be flexible about attendance patterns so as to accommodate the needs of individual children and families
- we will continue to consult local parents to ensure that the group goes on meeting the changing needs of the local community.
