Jews by Choice



Although most people associate Shavuot with Cheesecake, it is really an opportunity for us to celebrate the idea of being Jews by Choice. This phrase is usually associated with converts, but Rabbi Yitz Greenberg (a modern Orthodox Rabbi often known as the husband of feminist Jewish writer Blu Greenberg) suggests that in a post-Shoah world, everyone who shows up for their Judaism in any meaningful way is a Jew by Choice, because the Shoah shatters any sense of a covenant between God and the Jews, and so we must make the effort to engage with our Judaism rather than assume we are obligated to it.

Of course Shavuot has long been a festival that has celebrated Jews by Choice, from reading the book of Ruth and honouring the first active convert, to celebrating the choice the Israelites made in accepting Torah on themselves.

It's hard for me this month, however, to not feel acutely aware that my daughter, Eliana, stands on the cusp of choosing her own Judaism too. In July she will take to the EHRS bimah as she becomes Bat Mitzvah in our community, and continues to choose to show up as a teacher in Orot, our Cheder, and in who knows what ways into the future!

It is a surprisingly awe inspiring thing to witness in what ways your own children will make their Judaism meaningful in their lives, so that they want to be Jews by Choice too. We know that for many there is an assumption that being at Jewish Day Schools is enough Jewish for our young people, but studies conducted a decade ago in the US revealed some fascinating answers to the question we are often posed as clergy; how do we get the next generation to show up and be engaged?

There is no one simple answer. But the research clearly showed an important element of the answer. They explored over a number of years the things that gave young people the strongest Jewish identity into their young adult lives. They looked at Jewish Day Schools, Israel Tours, Cheder etc. The one thing that came out above and beyond anything else as a factor in establishing strong Jewish identities was having parents that volunteered their time for their communities. Young people who see that their parents enjoy and benefit from congregational life, and that in making a contribution their parents get as much as they give, were significantly more likely to themselves find the right role to inhabit in their own Jewish lives.

Eliana likely won't choose to be a Jew quite like me or her father, but as she becomes Bat Mitzvah, I hope she continues to be a Jew by choice, discovering the joy of giving and receiving in community, and of contributing meaningfully to its future.

Services

Erev Shabbat Service, 18:30-19:20

Our Erev Shabbat Service takes place every Friday evening. Led by our Clergy in person at the Synagogue and through the EHRS Livestream Classic Channel. They give a beautiful sense of rest and togetherness to help you to cope with the stresses of the world. Once a month our *Shirah* (musical) or *Shirah SheBaLev* (accapella choir) Friday night services enhance the experience with great music.

Shabbat Morning Service, 10:30-12:30

Our Shabbat Morning Service is held in the EHRS Beit Tefillah (sanctuary). The service is also available on the EHRS Livestream Classic Channel.

Children's Shabbat Experiences

We aim for there to be a special Shabbat experience for children every week at EHRS. Our Shabbat Shirah and Shabbat Club on respectively the second and fourth Shabbat each month are especially created for children to enjoy. On the first and third Shabbat, from 10:45–11:15 our Clergy and educators run Torah Time or Build a Bible sessions for any children that would like to join them. Kuddle Up Shabbat , 16:15-16:45

Our special interactive Shabbat service for Primary aged children and their siblings. Songs, stories and activities. You can collect CRP points from attending. Early arrival is optional from 15.45. Come straight from school pick up, or just arrive early to play before the service. Selection of toys for the children and hot drinks available for the adults.

Early Risers Service - Second Shabbat of Each Month, 9:30-11:00

This especially friendly service is mostly in Hebrew, uses nusach (traditional modes of chant for the prayers), includes the Torah reading and Musaf (which is the repetition of the Amidah special to Shabbat) and other features to create a participative experience, ending with a hospitable Kiddush.

Sunday Shacharit, 9:30-10:00

Half an hour of morning prayer with a friendly bunch of folks, includes the Kaddish if you are remembering a loved one. On the first Sunday of each month, it includes a bagel breakfast.

There is no doubt that all of us have been affected by what took place on October 7 2023. Over 1000 men, women and children were murdered by Hamas on that fateful day including Jake Marlowe z'l, a child of EHRS members.

It is now time for us to honour and respect those who have perished, so we are going to create a memorial which will be sculpted by Josette Perloff, one of our own members.

This memorial, which will cost about £7,000 will be situated in our memorial garden, and will be based on a tree - Eytz Chayim- a tree of life. It will remind us of the trees at the Nova Music Festival as well as the trees at the kibbutzim where many lost their lives.

We hope to unveil this sculpture at Sukkot. Sunday October 5, but clearly we do need your help to raise the funds. Please, I urge you, go to ehrs.uk/memorial-sculpture-donation.

Four years ago we raised in excess of £30,000 which allowed us to create a new Torah Scroll in memory of Rabbi Neil Kraft z''l who died in the early days of Covid. Your generosity was immense and hopefully you will also wish to contribute towards this sculptured tree which will be an everlasting memorial to those who were murdered on October 7 2023.

The names of those who donate will appear in the High Holyday issue of LeDor VaDor.


