Sukkot Term Theme: Torah

Learning about your portions and how that fits into the overall story of the Torah. Ours synagogue scrolls carry stories of our histories. Develops a relationship with the Torah that enables you to understand it and the Jewish literature that derives from it e.g. Midrash Talmud, as living documents with meaning in your lives.

Pesach Term Theme: Avodah

Learning about how the Shabbat service works and preparing you to become more fluent and confident to participate in Services. Includes participating in an explanatory Friday night service where you can share your learning. You will understand the structure and purposes of our prayer services in a way which enables you to transfer this knowledge to any other Jewish setting.
